Replacing Teachers

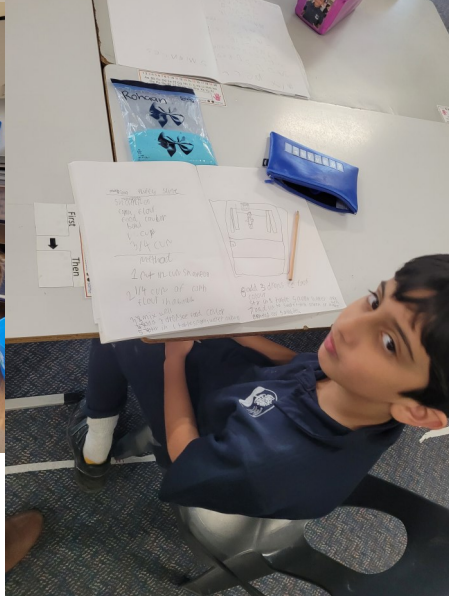
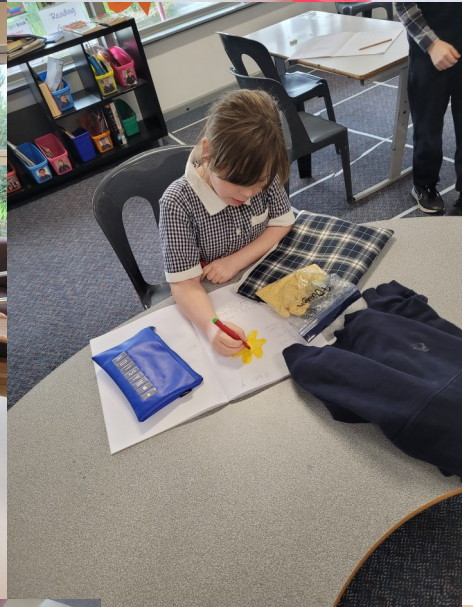
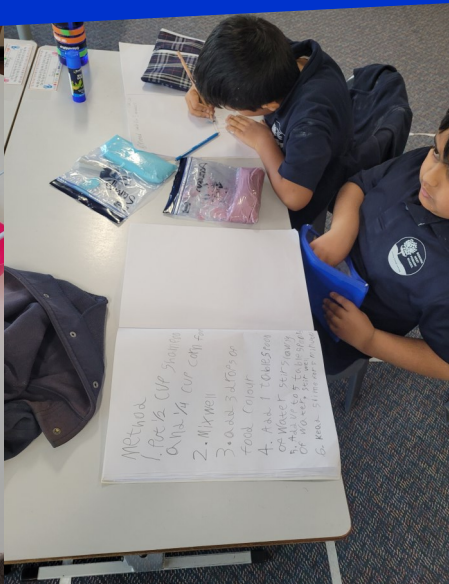

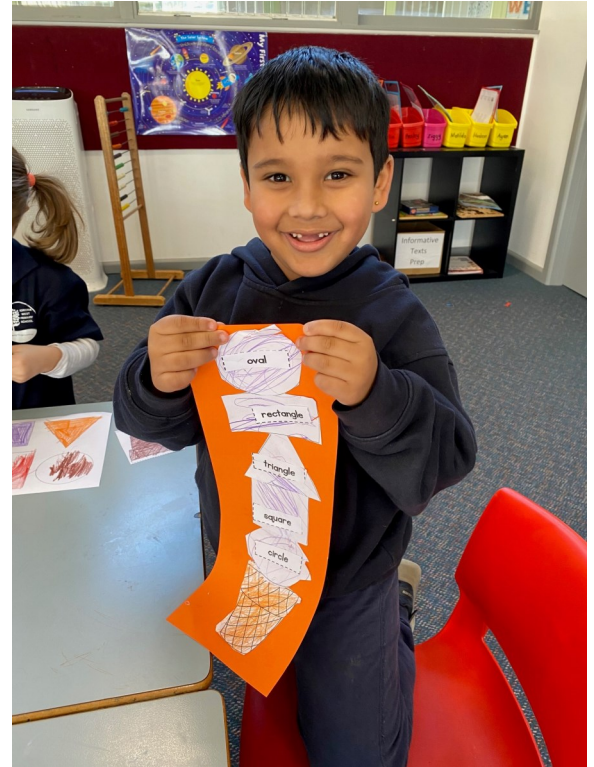
Making Slime

School Wide Positive Behaviour

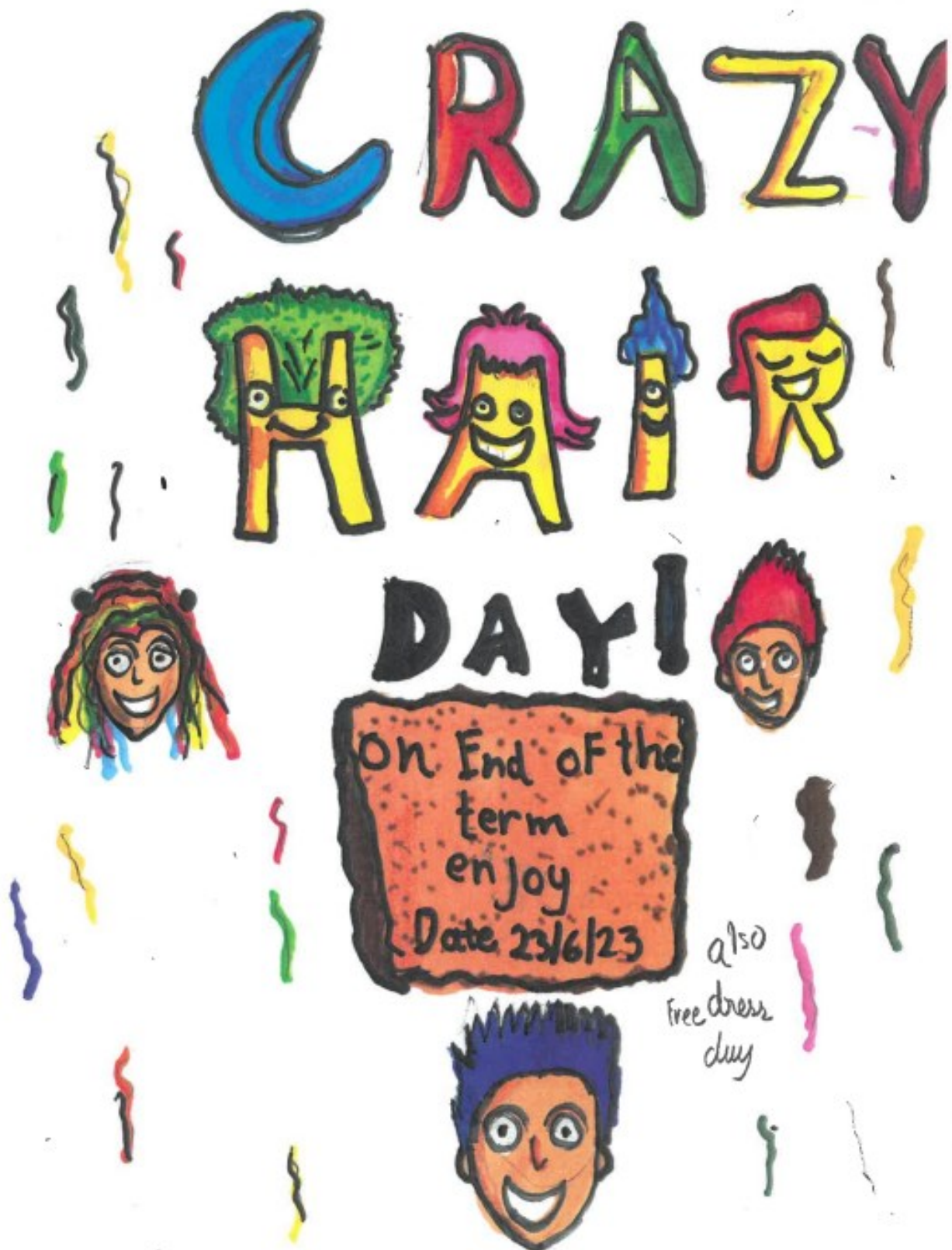


Students earned 2 leaves this week which is 200 acknowledgements of positive behaviour.
