On Tuesday 22nd August we will be having a Book Week celebration day including a Book Character Dress Up Parade.



The Prep and Grade 1 students were very excited this week to see the arrival of 28 chicken eggs.

We set up the incubator, and each student was able to put one or two eggs into the cradles. The incubator will keep them warm until they are ready to hatch in 21 days time. We are expecting the hatching to begin on Monday 28th of August, after which we will be able to handle and play with the chickens.

We are hatching three types of eggs: Australorps, Silver spangled Hamburgs and Speckled Sussex. It's a very exciting time for us, so watch this space for an update soon.


