Students were using chalk circles to share equally their teddy bears.

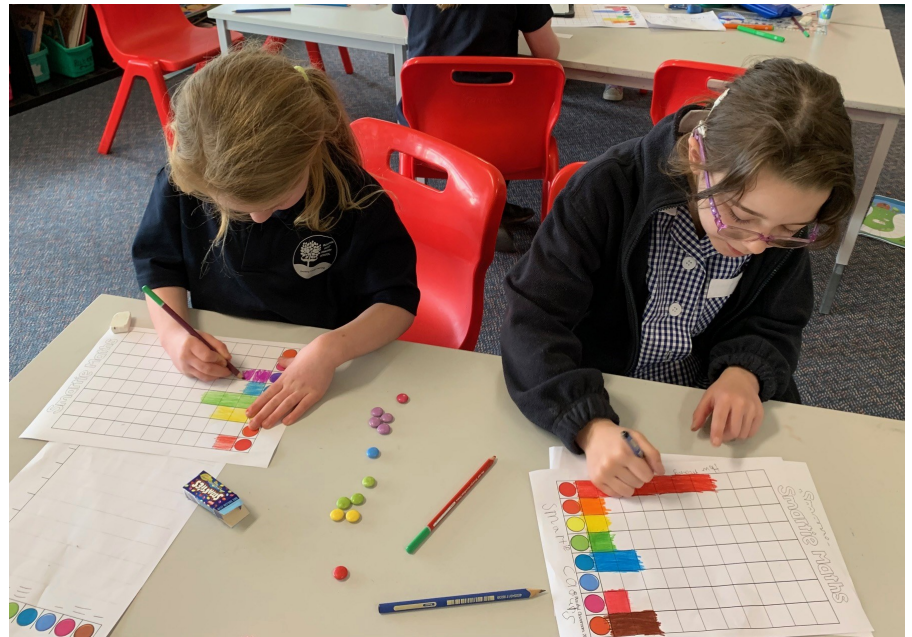
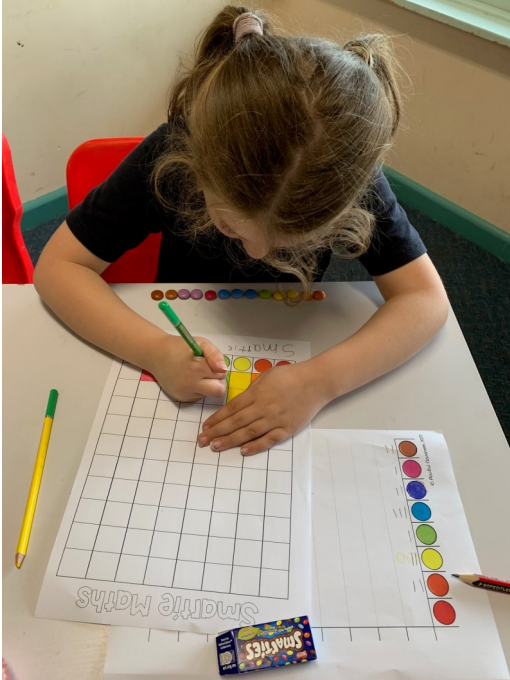
This is a great activity to learn the mathematical concept of division.
