CLASS REWARDS

Many families would know that students work towards filling the leaves on our tree to gain a whole school reward. But did you know students also receive class based rewards. Each time a class fills a tube of tokens—representing acknowledging 100 positive behaviours—students receive a class reward. In each class students decide what the reward will be. They can select from their 1 tube reward, or they can bank the tube for a 2 tube reward, or again bank them for a 3 tube reward. The more tubes for a reward, usually means a bigger reward.

When classes are having a class reward teachers will communicate with families.
